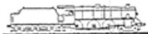

AFFILIATIONS

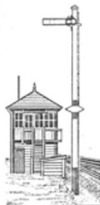
It is proposed to have affiliations with the Railway Correspondence & Travel Society and North Yorkshire Moors Railway.

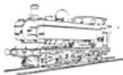
