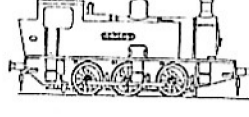

CONSTITUTION

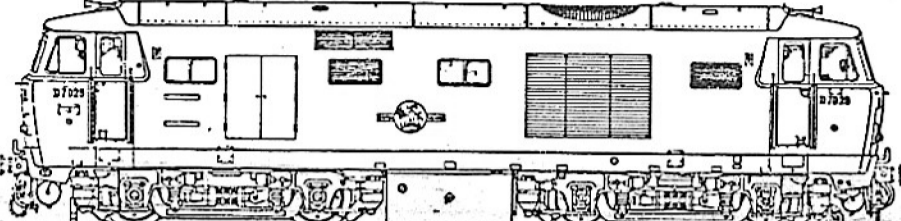
The Committee is preparing a Constitution for the Society. A copy of the final proposal will be forwarded to all members early in the new year.

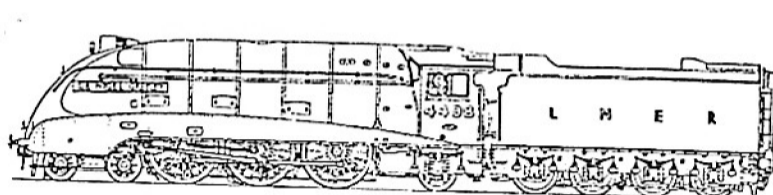
Members to give talks, &/or demonstrations on any railway topic for future meetings. Please contact the Secretary.

SUBSCRIPTIONS.

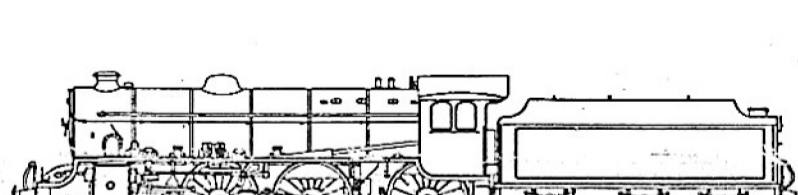
