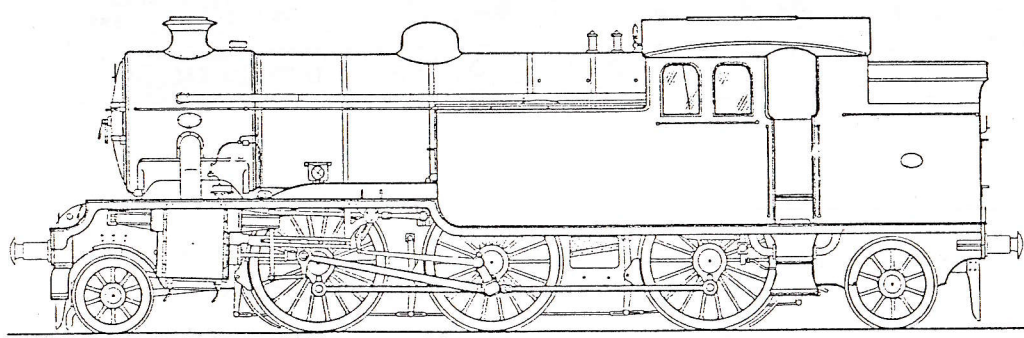

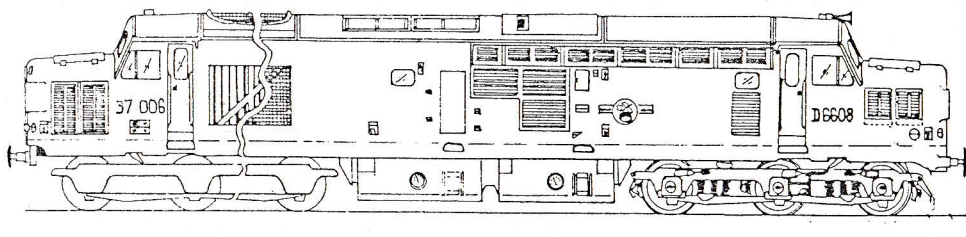

SOUTH YORKSHIRE RAILWAY COMPANY

The South Yorkshire Railway is one of Britain's newest preserved lines. Restoration is currently at an early stage, but the group have formed a limited company to support all future moves towards the re-opening of a section of the Blackburn Valley Line between Meadowhall and Chapeltown.

The proximity to the Meadowhall shopping complex, just a stones throw away, will undoubtedly boost the railway's income once services begin. To make this prospect a reality the railway needs as much support as possible.
