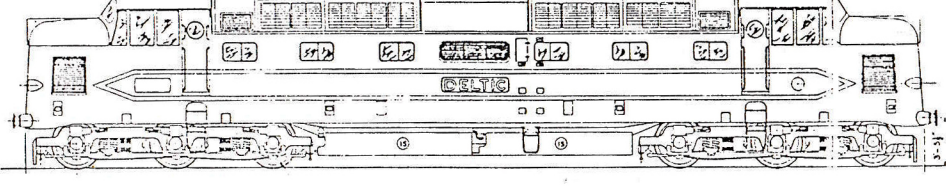
OUTING TO THE EAST LANCASHIRE RAILWAY

Full details will be available at the Society evening on 1st June.

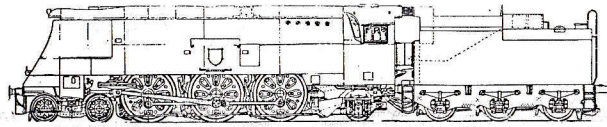
THE SOCIETY HEADBOARD

Categories will be as follows:-

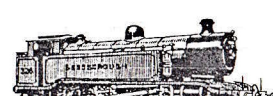

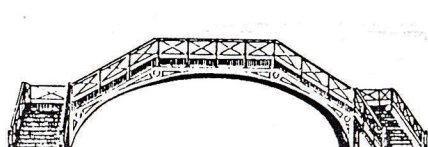
